- Perry provided an update on the activities the Youth Council interns have been participating in which include the Holiday Breakfast at Camp Lyndon & upcoming Pizza dinner at the Boys & Girls Club.
- Kara & Ken welcomed the new members of the Youth Council
- Ayanna Parrent, owner of B Free Coaching & Consulting was the guest speaker. Ayanna is a licensed social worker, certified school adjustment counselor as well as fitness instructor in multiple group fitness areas. Ayanna, provided an overview of her business B Free Coaching & Consulting. B Free is a coaching and service that combines exercise, mediation and yoga into helping individuals change through mindfulness and exercise. Ayanna has expertise in working with families, schools, addiction treatment centers and correctional facilities. Ayanna is also well-versed in working with teens and has begun exploring the possibility of working with local high schools.
